CHARITY UPDATE

Angela Woody presented a report on charity activities.

- Fairview Elementary School sent a letter to Starfish expressing thanks and sharing the joy the kids had for receiving donations.
- Looking for Jul/Aug/Sep dates and needing volunteers for sewing event for Xmas pillows. All welcome regardless of sewing ability as other tasks are needed as well. Needs to be done by end of September.
- Fund Raising Event planned for 20 Sep at the Armacost Museum.
 - Targeting 20 tables of 10 but need to confirm a realistic number, as you can't drop the number you start with. Consensus is to go with 100 as the target.
 - Currently planned for 4-8 pm with Jack Stack catering.
 - There will be a Hot Wheels race at the event, as well as other games and a silent auction/raffle. Entry fees for the race/games and auction/raffle proceeds will go to the Starfish Foundation.
 - Motion to allocate \$5000 to open funding for this event voted on and passed.
 - Aiming for a smaller fundraising event in 2025, and start planning a larger gala in 2026.
 - Registration will be \$60.

- Brian Gay was confirmed by vote as the Safety Director/Club Racing Co-Director.
- The club needs to appoint a Membership Co-Chair to support Bob Young.

- Kansas Speedway Car Show
 - KCRPCA was asked to participate in the 28 Sep event.
 - \$45 fee - get a reserved seat and pass along with VIP parking to the NASCAR race.
 - Board voted to politely decline due to conflicts with our DE/Club Race event.
- John Sherard proposed to adjust groupings at the All German Car Show. Instead of by colors, more by generation and/or air-cooled vs water-cooled, etc. This should more evenly break up numbers per category. Also working to simplify the QR code process.
 - Mark Anderson suggested a People's Choice award for participant voting. Board agreed that independent judges for the categories would be a positive experience, instead of internal members only.
 - Board agreed to proposed changes and gave John latitude to make adjustments.
