MINUTES:

The review of September 2025 Minutes was led by Deborah Thorne.

- There were no questions or changes.

TREASURER’S REPORT

Doug Tunnell presented the Treasurer’s Report.

- As per discussion at the last meeting, Doug presented an adjusted budget report to reflect year-to-date versus same time last year for better review and comparison.
- The Sep DE was a success both financially and per attendee feedback.
- The All-German Car Show was also a success for our club. Concerns with how other clubs operate at the event are leading the KC Auto Museum to take ownership of the overall event.
- The Charity Dinner expenses were over budget but no concerns against overall club expenses. The board voted on and approved the motion that charitable collections from 2025 would be given to the Starfish Project. A check will be presented at the KCRPCA Holiday Party.

Rob Crane reviewed the Driving Tour events.

- St. Joe Drive - starting point address on website was wrong so Rob will ensure to share the correct one with Deborah for next year. Rob will also work to provide FAQs for Driving Tours to add to the website.
- Driving Tours next year will be more precise and strict with start times, similar to how Autocross does it.
- 01 Nov - Excelsior Springs Drive is ready to go.

Rudy Rodriguez presented an Autocross (AX) update.

- 18 Oct is the next event. Feedback continues to be positive.

Brendon Jenks and Mike Rehak reviewed the recent DE/Club Race event.

- Shoutout to Kim Mann for the Saturday night event. It was well-received and there was positive feedback from attendees.
- Great 2025. 24-26 Apr and 25-27 Sep at OIR in 2026.
- A potential event at the Des Moines track (MAM, I-29 Racetrack) is being discussed. The goal would be to include additional regions and add a Ladies Only DE. Details to come.
- Brendon proposed removing Club Races and expanding the DE to include a Porsche car show. For instance, on the Saturday of the event weekend, there would be a Porsche car show at OIR. There would be a fee to participate in the car show, then also potentially the opportunity to pay another fee to participate in a parade lap. Brendon and Mike will continue discussions and provide more details later.

CHARITY UPDATE

Angela Woody presented a charity update.

- Starfish Project Charity Dinner
 - Overall the event was well-received and the auction was successful. Angela has a list of items from the event that can be improved on for 2026. Planning will begin now to allow for more lead-time for sponsors, setup, auction items, etc.
 - A committee will be formed to discuss lessons learned from this year's event and begin planning for 2026's event. The board will be updated on those discussions as applicable.
