DRIVING ACTIVITIES

 - Brendon pushed for more publicity around the event to make sure members know they need to register, unlike our typical non-racing driving events.

Deborah presented Autocross (AX) updates in Rudy Rodriguez's absence.

- No updates.

CHARITY UPDATE

Angela Woody shared a charity update.

- Starfish Fundraising Event will be held 18 Jul 2026 from 4pm - 8pm at Bourmont Winery.
 - Vendors will be on hand, but not to drive direct selling. It will give them the opportunity to interact with potential customers and show club members what services are available. Vendors will pay to set up their booths, starting at \$500.
 - The 3 bars on site will be set up to have a speaker in each to cover areas of education/interest. Topics are under discussion.
 - The charity committee is working with Porsche KC to provide cars for display throughout the event space.
 - The event space cost is \$5500. Food is \$7049. Attendance fee will be \$50 per person.
 - The board voted on and approved moving forward with the planning and execution of the

event as outlined by Angela's presentation.

- Angela will bring containers to breakfasts for donations - both for materials and for cash donations. There will also be a donation spot at the Escape to the Ozarks event.
- McPherson Matching Day is in early March. The previously approved \$2500 will be sent by the club in time for that matching.
